Dr. Herring is a UW clinical professor in the Departments of Rehabilitation Medicine, Orthopaedics and Sports Medicine and Neurological Surgery. He is the director of Spine, Sports and Musculoskeletal Medicine for the UW Medicine Health System and co-medical director of the Seattle Sports Concussion Program, a partnership between UW Medicine and Seattle Children's Hospital. He specializes in non-operative musculoskeletal and sports medi-

cine, with a particular interest in spine disorders and sports concussions. Dr. Herring is a team physician for the Seattle Seahawks, Seattle Mariners and a consultant to the Seattle Storm. He is working to help pass similar legislation in all fifty states and the District of Columbia.
